After a two year fellowship in Gastroenterology, Hepatology, and Nutrition at the University of Florida, University Hospital, Jacksonville, Florida, Dr. Dumas entered private practice in Venice in 1988.

Dr. Dumas maintains staff privileges at Venice Hospital and courtesy privileges at Englewood Community Hospital. He is a member of the Sarasota County Medical Society, the Florida Medical Association, the Florida Society of Internal Medicine, the Florida Gastroenterological Society, and the American College of Gastroenterology.
